*Recruiting the Next Generation of
Scholars in Population Research*



NextGenPop (NGP) is an undergraduate program in population research that trains and nurtures the next generation of population scientists. **Students from underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.**

NextGenPop Fellows will study population composition and change through the lens of pressing contemporary issues in population health, including health disparities, family change, immigration, and social mobility. The program includes a 2-week, in-person, on-campus summer experience and subsequent virtual components focused on research and professional development, as well as opportunities for mentorship and networking.

The summer 2026 program will be hosted at the **University of Minnesota** from June 7-19. The program provides a stipend, room, board, and travel support.

Following the summer program, NGP Fellows will participate in monthly virtual workshops on research and professional development. In the spring of 2027, they will have the chance to meet with population scholars from across the country and reconnect with their NGP cohort at the annual meetings of the Population Association of America in Seattle, Washington.
